WHEREAS Council has passed the *Whitefish River First Nation Trespass Bylaw 2020*;

AND WHEREAS a state of emergency has been declared by the Council under the *Whitefish River First Nation COVID-19 Virus By-Law* because of the COVID-19 pandemic, which constitutes an emergency under the *Whitefish River First Nation Trespass Bylaw 2020*;

AND WHEREAS section 7 of the *Whitefish River First Nation Trespass Bylaw 2020* authorizes Council to pass resolutions which describe classes of persons who are Trespassing on the Reserve for purposes of issuing Notices to Vacate the Reserve to them under the *Whitefish River First Nation Trespass Bylaw 2020*:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- During the state of emergency that has been declared by the Council under the *Whitefish River First Nation COVID-19 Virus By-Law*, Council authorizes any Officer as defined under the *Whitefish River First Nation Trespass Bylaw 2020*, any Councillor, any member of the Incident Response Team or the Community Control Group under the Emergency Response Plan approved under *Whitefish River First Nation COVID-19 Virus By-Law*, or any administrator or employee of Whitefish River First Nation, to issue and deliver a written Notice to Vacate the Reserve as defined in the *Whitefish River First Nation Trespass Bylaw 2020* to any person who is Trespassing on the Reserve and who falls within the following classes of persons:
 - persons who are not Band members or Dependent Family Members and who are residing in cottages /structures on the Reserve, whether or not they hold an authorization under the *Indian Act* such as a permit issued under section 18 or 28 of the *Indian Act* or some other form of authorization from Whitefish River First Nation;
 - persons who are not Band members or Dependent Family Members and who are found to be visiting, staying at or residing at locations or dwellings on the Reserve other than in cottages/structures on the Reserve.
- Notices to Vacate the Reserve shall provide 6 hours for the person to either vacate the Reserve or to request an opportunity to send written representations to Council under section 13 of the *Whitefish River First Nation Trespass Bylaw 2020* if the person wishes to dispute that the Notice to Vacate the Reserve should be enforced.
