NOTICE TO ALL TENANTS OF WHITEFISH RIVER FIRST NATION AND WHITEFISH RIVER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

This letter will advise tenants **that Whitefish River First Nation continues to remain in a State of Emergency, and access is restricted.** With the Provincial lock down and stay-at-home order lifted, tenants will now be able to resume accessing their camps as per our September 14th 2020 Cottage Lot Re-Opening plan. Tenants will not be required to submit WRFN Screening forms. However, should you have contractors coming in, they will be required to submit the WRFN COVID-19 screening forms to the Lands Department.

It is important to announce that **only** Lease/Permit holders and their immediate family members who have submitted waivers are permitted to access the camps until further notice. Tenants are to follow proper COVID-19 prevention methods by staying at your cottage, wear a mask when in public spaces, wash hands frequently, and abide by provincial gathering limits, and maintain social distancing.

Please be advised that in the event of another provincial lock-down and stay-at-home order comes into effect, Tenants will be required to vacate their camps immediately, and stay at their primary residence off-reserve. No exceptions will be made.
