**Notice to all tenants of Whitefish River First Nation
and Whitefish River Development Corporation**

On October 23, 2020, the security checkpoints on Old Village Road were removed. However Whitefish River First Nation (WRFN) **remains under a State of Emergency.** This letter will advise you that WRFN will continue its monitoring efforts and the occupancy of recreational lots

Requests to access your cottage during the winter will be permitted provided that you have submitted your waiver forms, abide by WRFN Travel protocols, and you are required to advise the WRFN Lands Department at least one week in advance by email.

We remind you at this time, that only leaseholder(s) and their immediate family members are permitted, and that you to follow proper COVID 19 prevention methods by staying at your cottage, wear your mask when entering public spaces, wash hands frequently, and Gatherings of 10 or more people **SHALL NOT** be permitted, and avoid any non-essential travel.
