EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORDER – RECREATIONAL LEASES & PERMITS

WHEREAS an Emergency was declared on March 24, 2020;

AND WHEREAS the criteria set out in the Whitefish River First Nation Emergency Response Plan and the COVID-19 Pandemic Plan 2020 has been satisfied;

NOW THEREFORE, this Order is made pursuant to Whitefish River First Nation BY-LAW NO.2020.02 – a BY-LAW RESPECTING COVID-19 VIRUS:

“Tenants and their immediate family members are authorized to be present on the Whitefish River First Nation Reserve, and may use and occupy their leased properties, provided they agree to abide by:

(a) the terms and conditions for use and occupancy and other terms and conditions recommended to Chief and Council, and adopted by Council as set out in a letter signed by the Chief of Whitefish River First Nation, and

(b) the terms and conditions of their lease.

The Emergency Management Order issued April 7, 2020 is revoked and is replaced by this Emergency Management Order.”
