# **WATER DELIVERY OPERATOR**

**Term: Permanent Part-Time**

*Hours: Up to 25 hours per week*

The Water Delivery Operator plays a crucial role in our community, ensuring the safe and reliable distribution of drinking water to the Whitefish River First Nation homes and buildings. This responsibility is vital in providing our community with a consistent supply of safe, clean water. The Water Delivery Operator also ensures the safety of the water vehicle and equipment, maintaining high standards of sanitation and cleanliness through regular checks and required documentation.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Conduct pre- and post-trip checks and inspections of the water truck and all equipment to ensure safe working conditions and delivery.
- Perform minor maintenance and repairs and inform the supervisor to obtain service when work is out of scope.
- Continually monitor water truck and equipment to ensure safe working order to minimize the risk of contamination, accident, injury, or death.
- Ensure following MTO guidelines, appropriate acts, regulations, other policies, procedures, and manuals.
- Follow the community water delivery schedule to homes and buildings to avoid outages.
- Transfer water from the water filling station to rural cisterns off the communal system.
- Verify and record chlorine and turbidity residuals.
- Maintain a log of all fill-ups and deliveries, including the date, time, location, and volume.
- Record any cleaning or maintenance of the water tank or water delivery equipment in the log book.
- You'll be part of a supportive team, attending daily updates and staff meetings as required. This collaborative environment ensures that everyone is informed and working towards our shared goal of providing safe, reliable water to our community.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Highschool Diploma or equivalent.
- Operator in Training would be an asset.
- Ability to be a team player and work independently without supervision.
- Mechanical aptitude to perform safety checks and minor maintenance.
- Basic math skills for records, logs, etc.
- Excellent understanding of the importance of safety.

### **DESIGNATION, LICENSES, AND REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must have a Valid Class "D" driver's license and acceptable driver's abstract upon hire.
- Recent acceptable Police Criminal Reference Check upon hire.
- Valid first aid and CPR or obtain upon hire.
- Hydrant Training, Confined Space Entry, Lock-out Tag Out, Working at Heights, Fall Protection, WHMIS, Workplace Harassment & Violence, Workers Health and Safety Awareness, Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG) or must be obtained during the probationary period.

### **SKILLS:**

- Ability to troubleshoot minor maintenance and operation problems.
- Excellent verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills for documentation and building and maintaining relationships with internal and external stakeholders.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision and follow directions, policies, and procedures to make informed decisions and understand when to seek clarity from the Supervisor.
