## FIELD TECHNICIANS

**Term: Full-time Contract (One-Year)**

*Hours: Up to 35 hours per week*

Salary: \$25-30 / hour (Depending on education and experience)

The Field Technician plays a crucial role in a variety of ongoing WRFN Lands projects. This position involves working on the land, reporting activities on the land, and sometimes working in adverse weather conditions. \*This position will primarily work outdoors.

### RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensure proper use of personal protective equipment.
- Keep the Lands Officer and Lands Manager apprised of all activities.
- Participate in training courses and professional development.
- Assist with our ongoing Walleye Project and play a significant role in enhancing our Rearing Pond Program.
- Assist in completing Aerial Surveys of our Leased Lots and our new Land Selection Areas.
- Assist with our Additions to Reserve Project and the cleanup of railway ties.
- Assist with Environmental Monitoring programs here in WRFN, including new projects and shoreline assessments of the Bay of Islands and McGregor Bay.
- Assist lands officer with environmental site inspection for land allotments and leased lots.
- Accompany 3<sup>rd</sup> party while working within WRFN territory.
- Maintain field equipment. Develop inventory and needs.
- Enhance our existing GIS database.
- Other duties as requested

### QUALIFICATIONS:

- Work experience or education in an environmental-related science would be an asset.
- Must have a complete "G" Driver's license and access to own vehicle.
- A pleasure craft license and experience driving a boat would be an asset.
- Basic Computer and Data Management skills are required.
